



MSHDA down payment assistance

Homeownership is closer than it appears with the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) Down Payment Assistance Program.

The funds provided by this program can be used for closing costs, pre-pays, and the down payment itself. The Down Payment Assistance (DPA) funds are not “free” money — it’s a state loan at a zero percent interest rate that is paid back when the house is sold or the mortgage is refinanced.

- \$10,000 Down Payment Assistance
- Buyer must have at least 1% into transaction
- \$544,233 maximum sales price
- 640 minimum credit score
- Manufactured (single wide or double-wide) are acceptable
- Buyer must complete a housing education class (can be completed online)
